Step 3: Then, take the sharpie and color in the circle for the nose

Step 4: Lastly, draw on the rest of the face for the hedgehog (eyes and

mouth as pictured above)

Trick-or-Treating Safety Tips ~



Fall season has arrived and it's that time of year again for all the fun and festive outdoor activities that are kid friendly. If you and your family are participating in Trick-or-Treating this year below you will find a few safety tips!

- Costumes- does your child's costume follow important safety protocols?
- It is encouraged that children wear bright colored costumes to make them more visible at night. With the change of seasons, it is beginning to get dark earlier.
- To prevent injuries and falls while trick-or-treating ensure that your child's costume is the proper fit. It's important that their costume isn't too long and that their shoes aren't too big as this will decrease the chances of any tripping accidents.
- If your child's costume has fun accessories that are included, ensure that these items are not dangerous to be running with in case of a fall. Also, if these accessories could potentially be a choking hazard to younger children it is important that they are always being monitored.
- It's a good idea to remind children of street safety and to be extra cautious of their surroundings. Encourage your child to stay on the sidewalk and to look very carefully before crossing the street.
- After trick-or-treating closely examine all candy to check that there are no safety hazards and that it is safe for your child to consume.
- Trunk-or-Treating is a great alternative to the traditional Trick-or-Treating. It
 is a safe option that still allows children to experience dressing up and
