Water Spongy Toys Craft

Supplies needed:

- Kitchen Sponges
- Zip tie
- Scissors









Water Spongy Toys Craft Instructions:

Step 1: First, vertically cut each sponge into 3 pieces



Step 2: Next, take a handful of the sponge strips, about 8-9 pieces and center a zip tie around the sponges and tie the zip tie tight around the sponge strips

Step 4: Cut off the excess zip tie

Step 5: Lastly, fluff up the sponge strips and now your child has a fun water toy for the summer!

This water sponge toy craft is great for outdoor water fun with the kiddo's. Dip the sponge into a bucket of water or even bring them into the pool to play with.

Bike Riding Tips:

Summer is in full swing and teaching your child to ride a bike can be an exciting time. It's important to remember a few tips when navigating this fun journey with your child.

- Ensure their helmet fits properly
- Check that their bike equipment is stable and safe
- Teach them the rules of the road
- Have them wear bright colors
- Ride in the same direction as traffic





- Remind your child to wear a properly-fitted helmet when biking, skateboarding, riding a scooter or in-line/roller skating.
- Check equipment. Make sure your child's bike is the appropriate size and works properly.
- Teach your kids the rules of the road. Make sure they know proper hand signals, understand traffic signs and signals.
- Be sure your kids are seen while riding. Wearing bright colors, using lights, and wearing reflectors will help them be seen.
- Teach kids to ride on the sidewalk when they can. If not, ride in the same direction as traffic as far on the right-hand side as possible.

IMPORTANT:

Eligibility Guidelines

- -The family resides in the state of Iowa
- -The family includes an individual with a disability under 22 years of age
- -The family expresses an intent for the family member who is an individual with a disability to remain living in the family's home
- The family's net taxable income is less than \$60,000 in the most recently completed tax year
